

There are plenty of indications that the Moncler jacket in question is not authentic



The logo embroidery on the left is from an authentic Moncler jacket and the embroidery is identical on ALL authentic Moncler jackets. It is not a match to the embroidery from the jacket in question, pictured on the right.



The brand label on the left is from an authentic Moncler jacket and the brand labels are identical on ALL authentic Moncler jackets. It is not a match to the label on the right which is from the jacket in question.

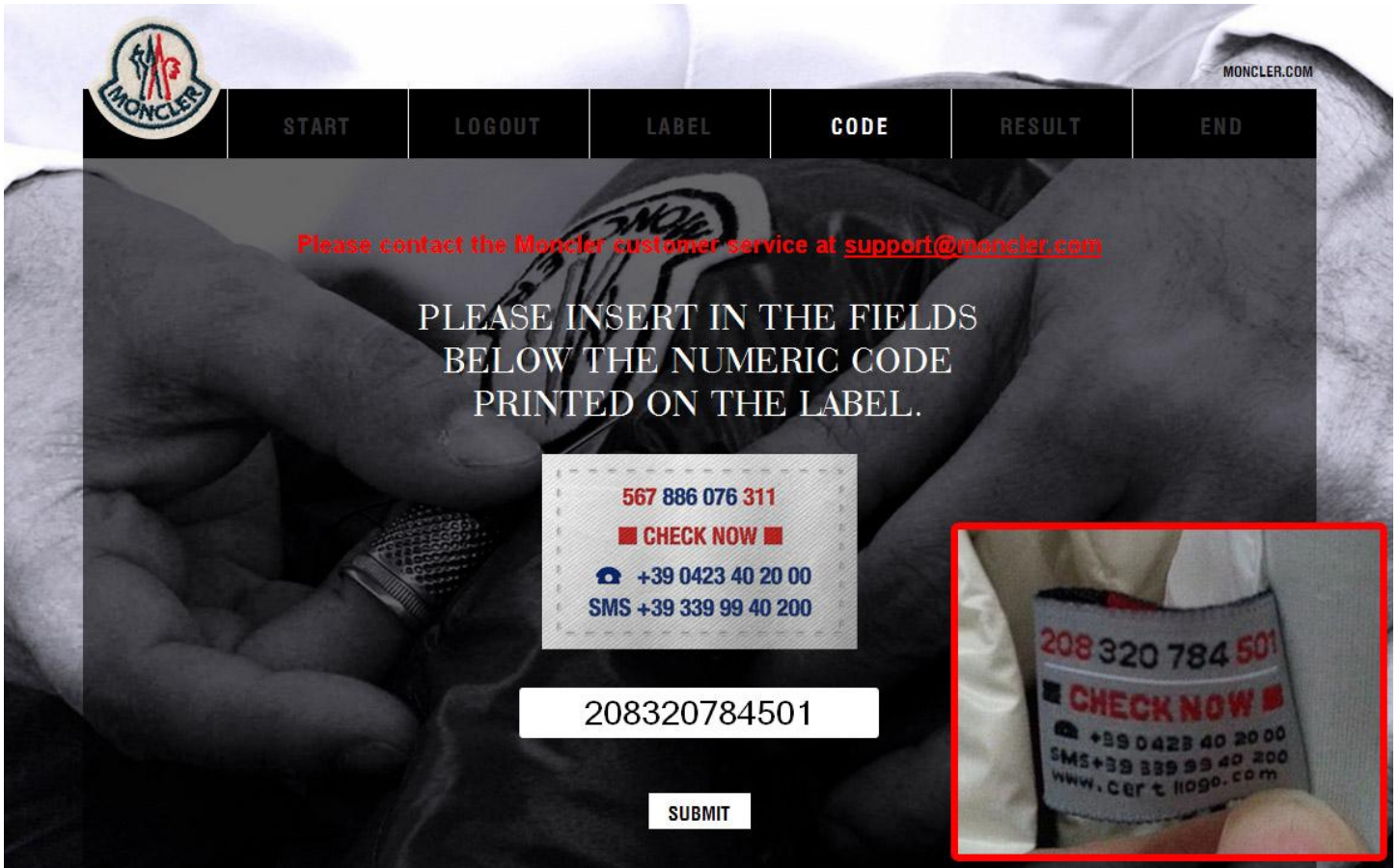


The tag inside the jacket indicates that it is a “Lucie” model/style of Moncler jacket.



The jacket on the right is an authentic Moncler “Lucie”. The jacket containing the “Lucie” tag, pictured on the left, is not a match to this particular model of jacket, but rather, a copy of a Moncler “Celsie”, pictured below.





The number from the certilogo tag does not register as a valid code on Moncler's website, hence the instructions in red to contact customer service regarding the jacket.

The jacket in question is determined to be a counterfeit
